Why study this course at Cronton Sixth Form?

This unique and intensive practical course has been developed for both creative and technical dancers who hold the relevant performance skills for today's dance industry, leading to training at a university, conservatoire or vocational dance schools.

Dancers studying on The Professional Dance Programme will have many opportunities throughout the two years to create and perform at a number of dance venues. You will take part in 3 large scale dance productions that are housed either in our own Cronton Playhouse or external venues such as The Brindley.

Taught by highly qualified industry professionals who have worked and toured nationally and internationally, The PDP is aimed at motivated and committed dance students who wish to pursue a career within the dance industry, such as performing, choreographing or teaching.

What will I study?

Dancers will participate in both practical and coursework assessments with an emphasis on performance, choreography and dance analysis. On the course, dancers will explore a range of dance styles including Jazz, Ballet, Lyrical, Contemporary and commercial. You will focus on 5 projects throughout each year which will build your skills in solo and group choreography, performing to an audience and professional practice.

How will I be assessed?

All of the assessments are marked either on coursework or your practical performances that we do throughout the two years. There are no written exams involved, however you will have practical assessment days.

Entry Requirements

A minimum of 5 GCSEs at Grade 9 – 4 including English Language including a minimum of a Grade 4 in English Language and a Grade 3 in Maths. Students are also required to take part in a two-stage audition process to establish their suitability for the course. This will be arranged following your initial admissions interview.

A Centre of Excellence

Students studying Performing Arts will become part of our Centre of Excellence. As such, they will be taught by some of the best teaching staff in the country and benefit from a wide range of extra-curricular activities to support their onward applications to the country's most prestigious institutions.

Students will develop their talents and professional skills by enjoying our wide range of experiences including; international trips, being part of industry standard performances, performing at professional venues, high profile patrons and professional links, free music tuition and nationally recognised Bronze, Silver and Gold Arts Awards.
