What will my timetable look like?

You will be in college for 3 days a week. During that time, you will spend time in gym, sports hall, field and classroom developing the theoretical and practical skills to equip you with the knowledge and skills required to work in the public service sector.

You will be required to complete some work experience and carry out voluntary work when required.

You will also have a 1-hour tutorial session with your assigned Personal Tutor who will cover your tutorial times. This will support you meeting your goals, prepare you for the world of work and help you to develop your CV. Your Personal Tutor will also help you manage your workload with an individual learning plan.

You will also spend time in the classroom learning the theory behind the subject and preparing for your assessments and working on your assignment briefs.

You will spend 2½ hours in Maths and 2½ hours in English working on improving your grades in these subjects.

This introductory course is designed to help you develop a wide range of skills and knowledge to enter a career within the public services or progress onto the level 2 extended certificate in public services. You will study a range of interesting subjects some theoretical and some practical. As part of your studies, you will get involved in activities that will help you to increase your confidence, develop your working skills and communication skills. By the end of this course, you will be familiar with team working, problem solving and running activities and events. You should expect to take part in fitness activities as part of the course, as well as enrichment activities.
