



# UCAS CLEARING PROCESS







### WHAT IS CLEARING?



Clearing is how Uni's and Colleges fill any places they still have their courses.

From 5<sup>th</sup> July – 20 October 2025, you can apply for a course using clearing if you're not already holding an offer from a University or College, and the course still has places.

You can use clearing if:

- You're applying after 30<sup>th</sup> June
- You didn't receive any offers (or none you wanted to accept)
- You didn't meet the conditions of your offers
- You've declined your firm place using the 'decline my place' button




### HOW CLEARING WORKS



Upon results day, 14<sup>th</sup> August 2025 at 8am, Universities are already aware of your results. If you log into your UCAS Hub and view offers upon opening results, you will either be confirmed (In green) or declined due to not meeting conditions of your offers (Red) and your offers will be withdrawn.

If unsuccessful, or withdrawn, this will be when you can use clearing.

You may also be offered an alternative course.





## **USING CLEARING**



If you have failed to meet the minimum entry requirements for your offers, decided to reject your offers and withdraw or have applied after 30<sup>th</sup> June. You may use clearing to find alternatives. Universities use the UCAS Hub to advertise courses they still have availability for. These might not be of interest or relevance to yourself.

UCAS uses your previous choices to suggest courses, which are available. You can view these and register your interest. However, others will be available, which can be found via the search tool. Upon registering your interest this alerts the University who may contact you to discuss. You can also call them to discuss options available to you.

Some Universities may conduct mini-interviews or use your personal statements.




# HOW TO COURSE SEARCH

Please check your UCAS Hub upon opening your results, as even if you fail to meet the conditions of your offer, your offer may still have been accepted based on your results.
