What will happen in my first week?

What can I look forward to in my first year?

You will learn about how the English Legal System works, and will study Criminal Law in depth. We will break down the elements of a crime, and study crimes and defences including: murder; manslaughter; theft; robbery; burglary; assault; battery; ABH; GBH; diminished responsibility; consent; duress and self-defence.
