

ANIMAL MANAGEMENT LEVEL 3



What will happen in my first week?

During induction you should expect to meet all of the Animal Care team and be introduced to your animals. You will also receive your personalised timetable so that you know exactly what the coming weeks will entail and where your lessons will take place.

Do I need to buy any equipment or kit?

You will be required to purchase uniform to enable you to carry out practical work with the animals. The supplier is 'Macron' – details of how to purchase this kit will be provided at enrolment at the end of August.

What will my timetable look like?

You will be in college 3 days a week, splitting your time between the Animal Centre and classrooms. Work experience is integral, with one timetabled day to complete the required 300 hours. The final day of the week will be designated as Extended Learning – self-study sessions – for you to complete tasks set to help you complete your assignments and revise for your Biology and Welfare examinations.

What can I look forward to in my first year?

In addition to looking after the animals in the Animal Centre, we will hopefully be able to visit a number of organisations to conduct husbandry activities such as behaviour studies. We will cover 7 units allowing you to explore a range of animal topics creating a rich and meaningful curriculum. There will be a huge focus on preparing you for the next steps on your education or employment. We will discuss the range of exciting animal related degrees you can progress onto and give you the knowledge and skills on how to apply.

What will I study in my first term?

In the first term you will be studying four diverse and interesting topics; Animal Biology, Animal Welfare and Ethics, Animal Behaviour and Practical Animal Husbandry.
