What will happen in my first week?

Induction week will consist of meeting your new tutors and future class members. In your first week you will participate in a variety of practical activities, designed to develop your team working skills and an initial assessment to understand your current knowledge and skills we can build on throughout the year.

What units will I study?

You will study: Being Organised, Working with Others, Researching a Topic, Developing a Personal Progression Plan, Planning and Navigating a Route, Finding out about Public Services, Assisting members of the public, Contributing to your community, Taking part in Sport and Adventurous activities, Taking part in Fitness Testing.

What can I look forward to on this course?

This introductory course helps you gain the skills and knowledge needed for a career in public services or progression to the Level 2 Extended Certificate. You will study both practical and theoretical subjects, take part in activities to build confidence, work and communication skills, and develop teamwork and problem-solving. The course includes fitness and enrichment activities, as well as opportunities to meet and visit public service professionals.

What will my timetable look like?

You will attend college 3 days a week, combining practical activities (gym, sports facilities, and field) with classroom learning to develop skills for public service careers. The course includes work experience, voluntary work, and weekly support from a Personal Tutor to help with goals, workload, and CV development. You will also spend time improving your English and Maths, with 2½ hours dedicated to each subject.
